Existing services: consisting of 108 bedded Hospital with OPD, Surgery, Medicine, Gynaecology, a flourishing Dental and Maxillofacial Surgery Unit, various investigations, CCU unit, emergency, Oncology, Dialysis and other services, including CT Scan, Digital X Ray, Endoscopy, Radio diagnostic procedures and above all, a completely modern level III critical care unit, which has earned a big repute.

Vision:

The Calcutta Heart Clinic and Hospital Society (hereinto after referred to as CHCH) is a multidisciplinary hospital providing speciality care in various disciplines of medicine and surgery including both diagnostic and therapeutic modalities at a very low cost. It is pertinent to note here that specialist and super-speciality services in Kolkata and surroundings are practically not available to the economically backward sections. On the one hand the corporate hospitals are not affordable to the lower socio economic sections, particularly the BPL category, while on the other, the govt. teaching hospitals suffering from a deluge of patients coming from all the districts of West Bengal are unable to provide satisfactory service in spite of their best efforts. **This is the space in which CHCH renders its unique service.**

Besides these, society visualized to develop medicine bank, community health service, service to disaster affected persons across various parts of India.

Mission:

The mission of the project is to extend services with many diagnostic and therapeutic modalities like CT scan, Endoscopic investigation, Digital X- ray, a fully automated and upgraded lab, a fully equipped low cost Dialysis unit, Cath Lab, Angiography and Angioplasty, care of the pregnant mother with a fully equipped Neonatal intensive care unit etc. to the economically weaker sections of the society particularly the BPL category.

As part of the said goals, the hospital already accommodated CT Scan, Digital X Ray, Endoscopy, Dialysis unit with other facilities.

Objectives and activities of the Society

The Calcutta Heart Clinic & Hospital Society as a charitable Socio Medical organization and made it registered in the year 1975 under west Bengal societies Registration Act, 1961. This Society stands on its firm objective to provide all sorts of socio medical services to the needy and underprivileged in general and the BPL category in particular, through its two fold activities since inception.

In one hand it provides all sorts of in-house Cardiac and other medical treatment facilities with utter sincerity and warm hospitality at minimum possible cost. On the other hand it organizes a number of different sort of Socio Medical activities like holding pulse polio programme, free Diabetic Clinic and distribution of free insulin among the juvenile diabetics, preventive as well as curative medical camp free of cost at different slum areas and participation at most of the flood and other disasters in West Bengal and other states of the country and organizing various cultural programme for emancipation of ethical and moral values.

There are unceasing efforts among all the doctors, consultants, nurses, staff and members of the hospital Society for continuous up gradation of medical treatment as well as ethical and moral values for attainment of its goal.

In this process the Society has been able to develop a team of Consultants-doctors-nurse-paramedical staff and social workers who have succeeded in developing the services provided for the economically backward sections of the Society to a high standard as a result of which it has earned a reputation of warm hospitality, deep affection and comprehensive totality treatment concept.



About Our Laboratory:

The Laboratory service is equipped with sophisticated autoanalysers (biochemistry), automated haematology analysers as well as high end machines for microbiological identification and drug susceptibility testing of pathogens. However, the greatest asset of the lab is a team of dedicated technologists led by a band of consultants including senior professors as well as dynamic young doctors with training from premier institutions like AIIMS, JIPMER etc. A penchant for perfection mingled with sincerity of purpose constitutes the basic philosophy of the daily functioning of the lab.

Eligibility :

As per State Medical Faculty of West Bengal (SMFWB) norms.

Duration :

Two years course followed by six months (600 hours) compulsory Post Examination Internship after passing Final Examination based on SMFWB norms.

Placement at Calcutta Heart Clinic and Hospital :

Placement at Calcutta Heart Clinic and Hospital will be mainly on merit basis as and when vacancy arises. However, the final decision regarding placement rests on the management only.

Medical Examination :

Students are advised to bring their self medical declaration form as per format attached with the application along with Medical fitness certificate issued by the Registered Medical Practitioner. Students are also required to be medically fit in order to join this course.

In case of any further requirement/if the student needs to undergo any additional medical tests i.e Blood test etc. at the time of admission at Calcutta Heart Clinic and Hospital, the cost of the same will be borne by the students.

Internship Fees:

Calcutta Heart Clinic and Hospital will pay a monthly stipend of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two thousand only) per student during the course of the compulsory internship.
