1. A brief write-up about our Institute:

Shri Ramkrishna Institute of Medical Sciences & Sanaka Hospital, a 350 bedded super-specialty hospital with an upcoming medical college, facilitates tertiary health care, with a special provision for below poverty line (BPL) patients, which is one of the major goals of this institute. This hospital with its profound array of departments like General Medicine, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, Gynaecology & Obstetrics, Pediatrics, Ophthalmology, E.N.T., Pulmonary Medicine, NICU/PICU, Critical Care Unit, Dermatology, Psychiatry also cater to super-specialty departments like Interventional Cardiology (including Cath lab) and Neurosurgery. The Central Laboratory is functional (24x7) with ultra-modern equipments which include fully Automatic Analyzers for Biochemistry, Microbiology, Clinical Pathology, Hematology and Cytology services.

The department of Radio-diagnosis has round-the-clock services for CT scan (64 slices), digital Radiography including fluoroscopy and high end Ultrasonography with Colour Doppler study. There are six centrally air conditioned modular operation theaters in the hospital with modern equipments. The Casualty department, with 10 beds, provides round the clock emergency services and is fully equipped with life saving equipments. This institute also has 24 x 7 facilities for Pharmacy, Ambulance service and Blood Bank.

2. Location of the Institute, with road/rail transports to reach the Institute:

Shri Ramkrishna Institute of Medical Sciences is located in Malandighi, Durgapur with 45 acres of lush green campus. It is well connected by rail, road and air. Being 10 kms away from NH 2, to and fro auto and bus services are found almost any time of the day. Moreover it is about 20 minutes from Durgapur Railway Station and just about 30mins from the newly made Kazi Nazrul Airport, Andal.

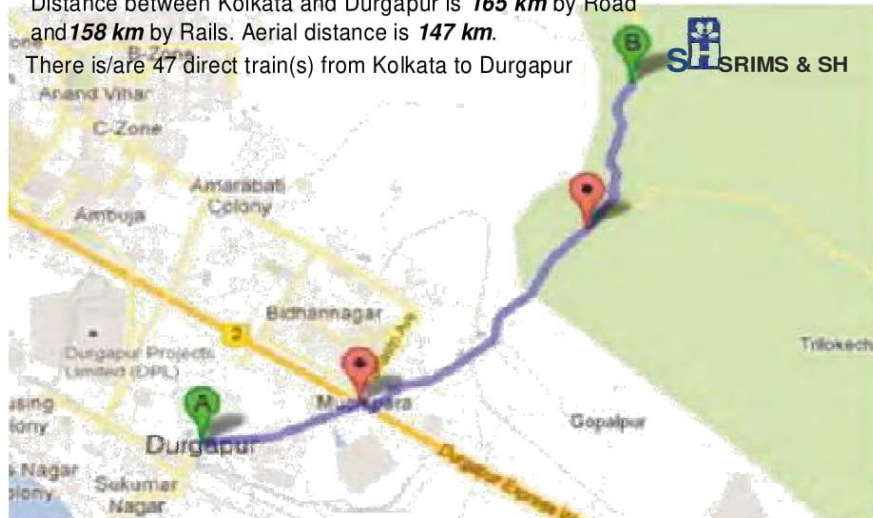
