About Tata Medical Center:

Conceptualised in the year 2004 as a philanthropic initiative for the Eastern and North-Eastern parts of India and the neighbouring countries, the Tata Medical Center (TMC) started operations in Kolkata on May 16, 2011. Its mission is to promote Prevention, Early Diagnosis, Treatment, Rehabilitation and Palliation and Research for cancer patients. The hospital is governed by a charitable trust – Tata Medical Centre Trust. It is an integrated Oncology facility with well-trained professional staff and equipped with modern facilities and the most contemporary medical equipment. Set up at a cost of Rs. 350 crores, the Hospital, with a capacity of 183 beds, serves all sections of the society, with 50% of the infrastructure earmarked for free or subsidized treatment for the underprivileged sections. Tata Medical Center is currently in an expansion mode with another 250 beds being added to the current bed strength.

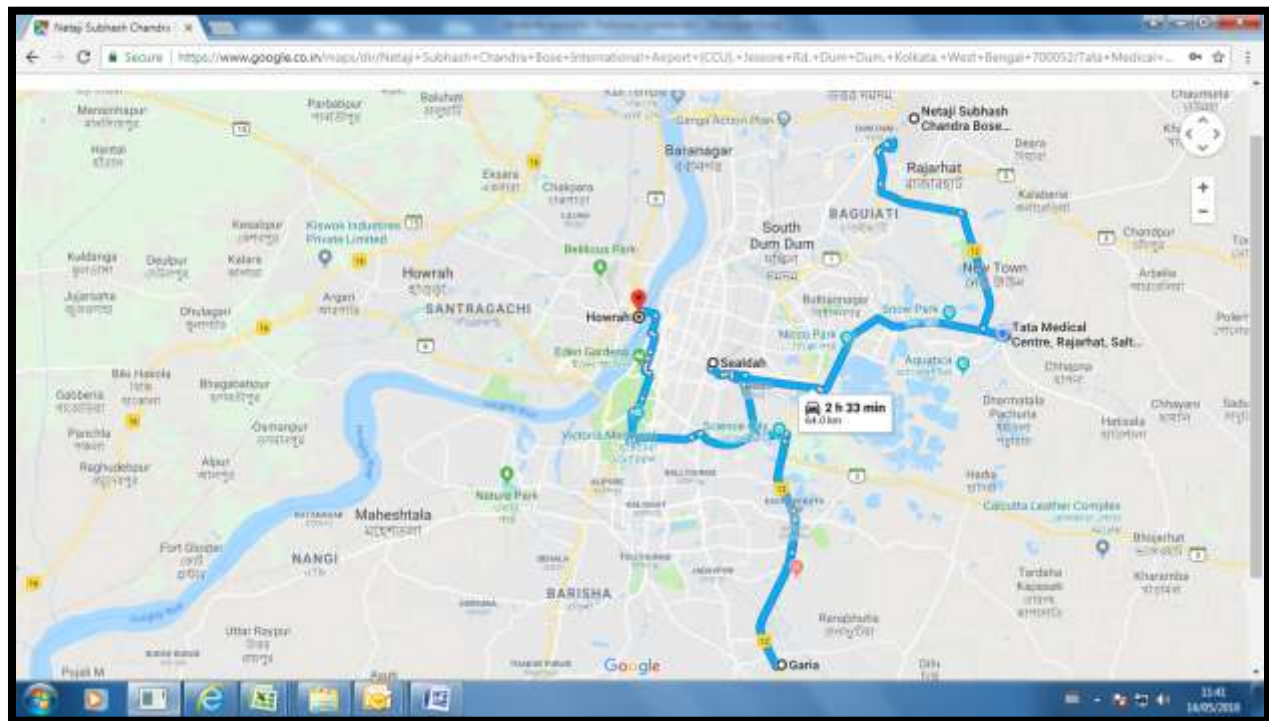
This hospital provides the entire spectrum of services from Prevention, Diagnosis, Therapy to Rehabilitation and Palliative support. Diagnosis and treatment is characterized by a multi-disciplinary approach with Disease Management Teams, wherein experts from different streams viz. surgery, radiation oncology, medical oncology, pathology, radiology, psychiatry and medical social work participates in decision-making for treatment protocols, using evidence-based medical strategies and appropriate documented clinical guidelines.

Eligibility

As per State Medical Faculty of West Bengal (SMFWB) norms.

Duration:-

Two years course followed by six months (600 hours) compulsory Post Examination Internship after passing Final Examination based on SMFWB norms.

Placement at Tata Medical Center: -

Placement at Tata Medical Center will be purely on merit basis as and when vacancy arises.

Medical Examination -

Students are advised to bring their self medical declaration form as per format attached with the application along with Medical fitness certificate issued by the Registered Medical Practitioner. Students are also required to be medically fit in order to join this course.

In case of any further requirement/ if the student needs to undergo any additional medical tests i.e Blood test etc at the time of admission at Tata Medical Center, the cost of the same will be borne by the students.

Internship Fees:

Tata Medical Center will pay a monthly stipend of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two thousand only) per student during the course of the compulsory internship.
